PRO Grant

The Parents Reaching Out (PRO) Grant is a program that provides funding for school boards in Ontario to remove barriers that prevent parents from participating in their children's education. School councils can apply for grants to support projects that engage parents, caregivers, and guardians.

How it works

- School councils work with their Parent Involvement Committee to identify barriers to parental participation
- School councils apply for grants to support projects that remove those barriers
- Projects are designed to respect the role of parents and families in their children's education
- Projects can focus on areas like social inclusion, racism, and mental health

Who can apply

- School councils can apply for grants to support projects that engage parents, caregivers, and guardians
- School councils must consult with and get approval from their school principal

What's needed for the application

- A description of the project, including its purpose, goals, and intended outcomes
- An estimate of how many parents, staff, and community members the project will reach
- An identification of any anticipated challenges
