Students entering Grades 10 & 11: Select one course from each of the compulsory (shaded) areas for your grade. Then select additional courses to make a total of eight (8) for the year.

Students entering Grade 12: Select *at least one more credit than required to graduate* in case of scheduling conflicts. Students planning to apply to University must take at least 6.0 courses at the 4U/M level.

IB and SHSM Program Options in grades 11 & 12: Students enrolled in IB or SHSM will have additional graduation requirements within their elective choices. Specialized option sheets are available in the KSS student services office.

All students: Once you finish planning on this page, you are ready to enter courses via your myBlueprint account. Guidance counsellors at KSS will manually review and approve all course requests and will follow up with students/families if there are questions or concerns.
